Training Opportunities through Shelter Tas

- **Support the recruitment, selection and induction of staff: 18th September**, Launceston 10.00am – 4.00pm (normally \$500, your organisation 100)
- **Show leadership in the workplace: 7th October**, Campbell Town 10.00am – 4.00pm (normally \$600, your organisation \$120)
- **Develop and manage performance-management processes: 29th October**, Hobart 10.00am - 4.00pm (normally \$600, your organisation \$120)
- **Manage workforce planning: 11th November**, Hobart 10.00am – 4.00pm (normally \$800, your organisation \$160)
- **Ensure team effectiveness: 2nd December**, Campbell Town 10.00am – 4.00pm (normally \$600, your organisation \$120).
