### Mortgage Repayments on the Rise

The ABS have released [a report](#) that looks at the median monthly mortgage repayments in rural and regional areas of Australia, based on census data. The fastest rates of increase in payments in Tasmania were in George Town and Southern Midlands LGAs, but rises were pretty much across the board.

The latest [AHURI Evidence Review](#) looks at the impacts on low-income households living in four “gentrified” suburbs, and the idea of “concentrations of advantage”.
